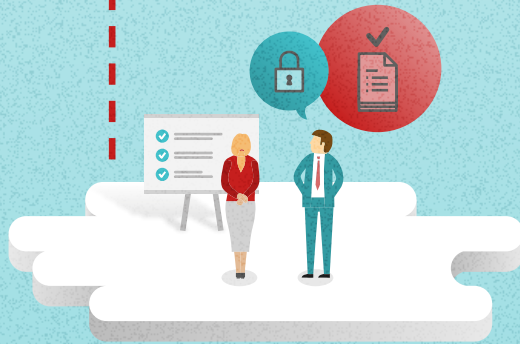


# Recovering WITHOUT A BUSINESS CONTINUITY PLAN

More than half of the respondents to the Data Health Check 2014 have a Business Continuity Plan (BCP) and 67% of them had tested DR capabilities in the last 12 months



What about the rest? Organisations with no BCP said they could recover, on average, faster than those with one (!?)



However, only 18% had tested DR capabilities in the last 12 months



## Who's calling the shots AND ARE THEY IN FOR A SHOCK?



### LARGE ORGANISATIONS

17% have adopted DRaaS

73% have a BCP

Responsibility for the BCP is split between dedicated Business Continuity Managers (27%) and IT Directors (22%)



### MID-SIZED ORGANISATIONS

22% have adopted DRaaS

54% have a BCP

Responsibility is split between IT Managers (22%), IT Directors (26%) and CEO/MD (19%)



### SMALL ORGANISATIONS

7% have adopted DRaaS

30% have a BCP

48% nominate the MD/CEO as ultimately responsible for the plan
